Preparing for Coronavirus

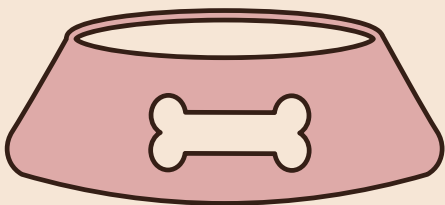
1 MEDICATIONS

Ensure that you have a 1 month supply of medications and a pet first aid kit on hand. Call your veterinarian to discuss your pet's medication requirements.



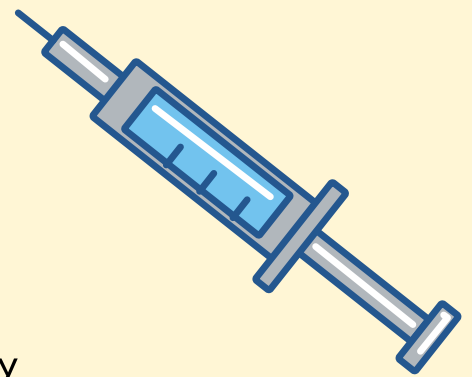
2 FOOD

Ensure that you have a 1 month supply of pet food on hand. If your pet is on a prescription or premium diet contact your veterinarian and order ahead for collection.



3 VACCINATION AND REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES

Keep these documents handy in the event that your pet requires emergency treatment or boarding, or is being looked after by a carer.



4 EXERCISE

Choose large open spaces to walk your dog. Avoid contact with other pet owners and wash your hands thoroughly when you return. Chew toys and games can help to ease boredom at home.



5 VET VISITS

Avoid non-essential visits and call ahead to book an appointment. Many clinics are implementing a Zero Contact policy where your pet is handed over outside and the consult is conducted by phone.
